Introduction and Overview

- The AICLET- PG will feature an emphasis on the comprehension abilities of the students. It shall be of 60 minutes duration.
- The section would include 100 objective-type questions carrying 1 mark each. There shall be no negative marking. The paper will be based on the mandatory subjects of the undergraduate program and will include Constitutional Law, Jurisprudence, Administrative Law, Service law, Law of Contract, Torts, Family Law, Criminal Laws (Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita and The Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha and the Bharatiya Sakshya, IPC, CrPC, and The Evidence Act), Property Law, Company Law, Public International Law, Tax Law, Environmental Law and human rights, and Labour & Industrial Law.
